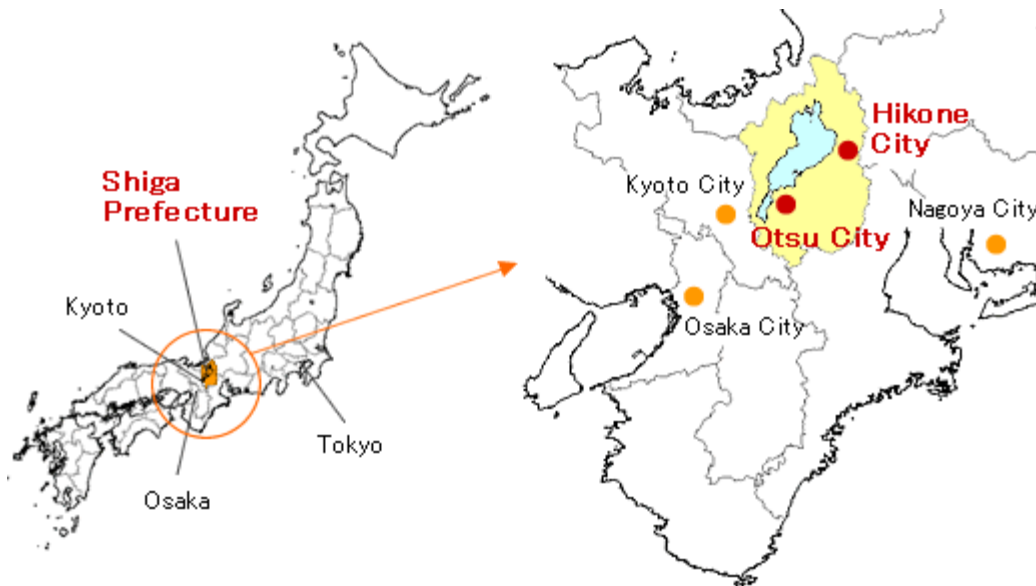

Japan Education Internship 2012

Program Summary

Two Lansing Community College Japanese Language students will complete a three-credit LCC independent study through the LCC foreign language program. Students must have a 3.0 or higher overall college grade point average, and have completed at least Elementary Japanese (JPN 121) or the equivalent with a 3.5 grade or higher.

Students will be assigned to Otsu, Shiga, Japan elementary schools, where they will serve as assistants to the school's 5th- and 6th-grade English teachers. The *tentative* 2012 program schedule is as follows:

Friday, May 25 - students depart Michigan for Shiga

Saturday, May 26 - students arrive in Shiga

Sunday, May 27 and Monday, May 28 - orientation in Otsu

Tuesday, May 29 – students begin internship in Otsu elementary schools

Monday, July 31 – leave Shiga and return to Michigan

LCC interns will work four days each week, up to 28 hours total time including internship duties, lunch time, and transportation between elementary schools. Internship duties may include:

- English dialog examples with classroom teacher
- English-language classroom activities with children
- English practice during lunch with children
- English practice during end-of-day clean-up with children

Housing

Apartment housing for international students is available in Otsu through Shiga Prefecture. Cost is approximately \$350 per month.
