

AMENDMENT TO ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Lansing Community College – Business Administration B.S.


THIS is an AMENDMENT to an ARTICULATION AGREEMENT (hereinafter “Agreement”) dated January 3, 2006, between Ferris State University, a Michigan constitutionally-created public institution of higher education, located in Big Rapids, Michigan 49307 (hereinafter “Ferris”) and Lansing Community College located in Lansing, Michigan (hereinafter “LCC”) entered into on this 15th day of August, 2011.

The Articulation Agreement entered into between Ferris and LCC is amended as follows:


1. LCC students who have completed the Associates Program or have completed at least forty-eight (48) transferable credits from LCC with a cumulative grade point average of not less than a 2.35 (on a 4.0 scale) or higher, and have completed or placed into LCC’s Math 112 or WRIT 121 or WRIT 131, or equivalent courses from another accredited institution, (hereinafter the “qualified student”) may apply to the Bachelors Program at Ferris.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Amendment as of the day and year written in the preamble to this Agreement.



The major in business administration is designed to prepare individuals for the rapidly changing nature of the work environment in business, government and other nonprofit organizations. The program is designed to equip graduates not only for entry-level positions but for advancement as well.

Building upon a core of business courses, the program features a tight sequence of major courses; however, the program also provides the flexibility to specialize in an area of interest for the student. Students with associate's degrees in a variety of areas will find the program attractive for building a solid knowledge of business and management skills. The major is also valuable as preparation for law school, as well as for graduate studies in business.

General Admission Criteria

To be admitted to this program you must have at least a minimum of 48 transferable credits and have an overall GPA of 2.35 or better and have credit for/or place into WRIT 121 or MATH 112. A minimum 121 credits are required for graduation.
