## Undergraduate Scholars Program

### Community College Alliance Scholarship

---

The Undergraduate Scholars Program offers a variety of scholarships, including the Community College Alliance (CCA) Scholarship. This is a competitive scholarship for Franklin University undergraduate students who are part of the CCA Program. Recipients are selected based on prior academic achievement and the quality of an essay. Scholarships range from \$200 to \$2,000 and may be used for Franklin credit hours only. Scholarships are non-renewable.

#### Requirements:

##### New Transfer Students

- A scholarship application must be submitted by the deadline. To download the application visit <http://alliance.franklin.edu/go/pay> and click on "Scholarships"
- An essay must be completed and submitted by the deadline.
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 from your previous colleges or university attended.
- Official copies of academic transcript(s) from other colleges must be on file at Franklin University.

##### Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship

Franklin also awards a Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship for new transfer students who are currently members of Phi Theta Kappa, a national honor society for two-year colleges. Applicants must meet requirements for the CCA Scholarship for new transfer students in addition to:

- A minimum GPA requirement of 3.5
- Confirmation of Phi Theta Kappa membership

##### Current Students

- A Scholarship Application must be submitted by the deadline. To download the application visit <http://alliance.franklin.edu/go/pay> and click on "Scholarships"
- An essay must be completed and submitted by the deadline.
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 at Franklin University.
- Completion of at least ten Franklin semester hours prior to the application deadline is required.

#### Deadlines:

Summer Trimester: March 1

Fall Trimester: July 1

Winter Trimester: November 1

#### Note:

- Students may receive only one type of University award per trimester. CCA Scholarship awards will be applied toward tuition for up to two trimesters for which the application is submitted. CCA Scholarship awards may not be used for audited courses.
- Scholarships can be used for Franklin credit hours only.
