
In accordance with the Agreement, LCC and MMCC have completed a programmatic review and have agreed to the changes listed below.


#### Notes:

1. The CPR requirement states the student must have a current CPR card, which includes adult, child and infant resuscitation. This requirement may be satisfied by successful completion of an appropriate American Heart Association course, Red Cross course, MMCC course or LCC course.
2. Course satisfies the LCC General Education Core Requirements.
3. Recognition of credit granted would appear on the student's academic record. Transfer students accepted by LCC with advanced standing must complete a minimum of 30 credits of satisfactory work at LCC to be eligible for graduation with an Associates Degree.
4. The Lansing Community College Surgical Technology Academic Team Leader will determine the total number of articulating students to be accepted. The program expects to accept a minimum of 3 MMCC students each year.
