

**Articulation Agreement
between
Lansing Community College
and
Palmer College of Chiropractic**

The purpose of this agreement is to enhance the transition of Associate degree graduates from *Lansing Community College* into baccalaureate degree programs at Palmer College of Chiropractic. The following agreement shall establish the conditions under which students from *Lansing Community College* shall progress to senior or upper division status. This agreement is without a specified termination date; however, either party may terminate the agreement at any time provided students then currently enrolled shall be allowed to complete their course of studies pursuant to the terms of the agreement in effect at the time of termination.

NOTE: Students wishing to participate under the terms and conditions of this agreement must complete an Associate degree program at *Lansing Community College*.

Palmer College of Chiropractic is accredited by The Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools. In addition the Doctor of Chiropractic Degree Program is accredited by the Commission on the Accreditation of the Council on Chiropractic Education. I. Articulation conditions for all *Lansing Community College* Associate Degree Graduates admitted to Palmer College of Chiropractic:

- A. Palmer College of Chiropractic shall accept the required general education credits earned at *Lansing Community College*, applying them toward the equivalent lower division, general education requirements at Palmer College of Chiropractic.
- B. Acceptance to Palmer College of Chiropractic will be contingent upon meeting all Palmer College of Chiropractic admissions requirements.
- C. *Lansing Community Colleges* courses not applied to Palmer College of Chiropractic general distribution, major or specialization will be accepted and applied as general elective credits.
- D. Admissions, financial aid, advisement, and registration services will be provided by Palmer College of Chiropractic to those students who express an interest.

II. *Lansing Community College* will provide the following:

- A. **Recruitment Table** – Space on campus for promotion of Palmer College of Chiropractic.
- B. **Graduate Listings** – After the annual *Lansing Community College* graduation, the College will provide “directory information” (as specified in the *Lansing Community College* catalog) on *Lansing Community College* graduates.

C. **Visit Awareness Marketing** – *Lansing Community College* will actively promote baccalaureate degree-granting institution campus visits [i.e., posters, brochures].


III. Additional Information

A. **Exchange of Information** – Palmer College of Chiropractic and Lansing Community College agree to exchange transfer student information for the purpose of monitoring and enhancing student academic success. An information exchange will at the minimum, include academic and demographic information required by the Michigan Department of Education, and the Michigan Department of Career Development for educational accountability reports. Additionally, the information will be used to improve and enhance curricular offerings to support student success. At no time will Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) regulations or requirements be violated.

B. **Communication** – Lansing Community College and Palmer College of Chiropractic agree to cooperate in communicating with each other and with their common and respective publics concerning the established relationship between the two institutions.


