The courses listed are currently transferable under the 2010 SCAD course catalog for specific SCAD requirements for the Bachelor of Fine Arts in Photography. Students are subject to the requirements of the SCAD course catalog in effect at the time of his or her entry and registration at SCAD. Students may choose to fulfill requirements of any subsequent SCAD course catalog within five years of their first enrollment at SCAD. This document is specific to the Lansing Community College's Photographic Imaging, Associate in Applied Science and the Savannah College of Art and Design's Bachelor of Fine Arts in Photography. In order for a class to be considered for transfer, it needs to be at least three semester credit hours or five quarter hours. A grade of "C" or higher must be earned in the class. A course transferred from Lansing Community College may fulfill only one SCAD course requirement. A maximum of 18 courses may transfer into the SCAD B.F.A. program of study. In some instances, a student's course selection may fulfill a different requirement than listed above. In those specific instances, it may be advantageous in the student's course of study to allow the course to fulfill a different requirement rather than a general education or free elective.


The Associate in Applied Arts, Photographic Imaging may not bring students into the BFA in Photography at SCAD with the potential of junior standing. Students must pass all portfolio reviews and should take additional suggested coursework if they wish to obtain junior standing at SCAD.




