

**Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN)/Baccalaureate of Science in Nursing (BSN)
Articulation Agreement
Between
Lansing Community College
And
The University of Michigan-Flint**

Purpose

The purpose of this articulation agreement is to provide a smooth transition for Lansing Community College ADN students transferring to the University of Michigan-Flint for completion of the BSN degree. The Lansing Community College and University of Michigan-Flint will maintain the integrity of their separate programs and enter into this agreement as cooperating institutions.

Goals

- Increase opportunity for ADN graduates to complete a BSN in an online or on campus environment at UM-Flint.
- Support and promote the value and benefits of community college transfer students to obtain a bachelors or higher academic degree.
- Promote an academic alliance between the University of Michigan-Flint and Lansing Community College through dialogue and interaction.
- Encourage students to apply and enroll at the University of Michigan-Flint.
- Enhance student academic preparation and transfer planning.
- Assist transfer students in the transition from the community college to the University of Michigan-Flint.
- Increase retention of transfer students through enhanced advisement and closely articulated academic course work.

Article I

The University of Michigan-Flint and Lansing Community College agree that any student who successfully completes the course requirements as delineated in this agreement may transfer up to 62 semester hours toward the Bachelor of Science in Nursing offered through the Department of Nursing, School of Health Professions and Studies. Transferability of specific courses is determined by the University of Michigan-Flint Office of Admissions in consultation with the appropriate academic unit.

The University of Michigan-Flint graduation requirements for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing include completion of the General Education requirements specified for the School of Health Professions and Studies, required prerequisite courses, and RN/BSN program specific courses. The UM-Flint RN/BSN program requires completion of a total of at least 120 semester hours for graduation. This agreement identifies specific courses that can be transferred from Lansing Community College as partial fulfillment of graduation requirements.
