Criminal Justice – Law Enforcement with Police Academy.</p> <p>Because law enforcement employment must be obtained within 1 year of successful completion of the MCOLES this agreement provides students with three options:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If a student desires to complete the Law Enforcement Program prior to pursuing their bachelor degree they may enroll in the B.S.C.D. program at a later date. 2. If a student desires to complete their bachelor degree prior to a career in law enforcement they may do so by completing all of the necessary courses and then enroll in the Police Academy at Lansing Community College. Once this has been successfully completed the student will need to complete and submit their Prior Learning Portfolio in addition to their transcript to CMU. 3. A minimum of 30 semester hours of CMU residency credits are required.</p> <p>Minimum credits taken at CMU 31</p>
