

Transfer Partnership LANSING COMMUNITY COLLEGE to EASTERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY

Elementary Education

(Revised December 2009)

This articulation agreement (partnership) with Eastern Michigan University permits LCC students to earn an Associate Degree and transfer up to 80 credits toward their Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education at EMU. **This agreement is not intended for special education or K-12 certification programs.**

Completion of the attached curriculum will satisfy requirements for MACRAO and the Associate of Arts Degree in Elementary Education. EMU requires three additional general education courses which are noted in the guide. To use MACRAO, students should request a MACRAO evaluation be noted on official LCC transcripts forwarded to EMU. If MACRAO is not complete, students must follow all EMU general education requirements.

This curriculum guide includes all courses necessary for a Structure of the disciplines minor. To satisfy all BA requirements, students must complete an additional major or two additional minors. A minimum of 60 credits toward the program total must be completed at the four-year college level, of which at least 9 credits in the major and 6 credits in the minor must be at the 300/400 level. Refer to the EMU undergraduate catalog for the list of majors or minors that may be used with the Structure of the Disciplines minor, as well as the requirements for each.

Students with a GPA of 3.0 or higher who have completed at least 56 credits and have passed the Basic Skills test are admissible directly to the Teacher Preparation Program. Students with less than a 3.0 must complete at least 12 credits at EMU with a 2.5 or better before admission to the program.

Students interested in transferring to EMU should attend an EMU elementary Education group advising session early in their program, before completing an admission application to EMU. Students must include a copy of the EMU version of the curriculum guide showing all EMU equivalent and substitute courses.
