

CG Curriculum Meeting

Please note: **anywhere I ran into problems and we still need discussion I marked it in bold.**

The primary topic of discussion was prerequisites for classes based on the changes to Web curricular guide. We also talked about names for classes used below are the ones to which everyone agreed.

ARTS 16x Vector Drawing -- prereq: ARTS 102 and ARTS 131EQv

ARTS 2xx Interface Design -- prereq ARTS 16x and ARTS 171  
(We actually saw this as perhaps a 100 level class because it is so fundamental to everything else.)

ARTS 17x Flash Programming for Artists -- prereq: ARTS 16x and concurrent ARTS 232 also has a MATH Level 5 so that students have dealt with math requirement before they take this class.

**Everyone -- this still is problematic. What do you think?** (To make this work this may need to be numbered a 200 level class.) This is still a sequence nightmare. What we need is to make sure that students know enough Flash to function in the Flash environment so that we don't make it also a "how to use Flash" class. Perhaps the Storyboarding class could be the prereq? or is 16x Vector Drawing going to be enough?

ARTS 226 Storyboards & Animatics -- prereq: ARTS 151 and ARTS 16x

ARTS 229 CG/Adv. Web Design -- ARTS 173 and ARTS 2xx Interface Design

ARTS 232 CG/2D Animation -- prereq: ARTS 132EQv and ARTS 226

ARTS 2xx Information Graphics -- prereq: ARTS 132 and and ARTS 162 and ARTS 16x and ARTS 171

ARTS 237 CG/Flash Game Design -- prereq: ARTS 17x  
**(Thought here how about making this one pre/co req with 232???)**

For purposes of this discussion we used ARTS 131EQv and ARTS 132EQv because it was easier.

We also discussed discontinuing ARTS 236. This would have implications beyond this discussion -- the Multimedia degree for example.
