Professional Floral Designers use plant material to design and create floral arrangements. A professional designer works with flowers and plants, understands and can apply design principles, is knowledgeable in the care and handling technology and treatment of plants and cut flowers, and can apply design techniques to merchandising and displays. Floral Designers are service orientated, creative and able to communicate ideas visually and verbally; they can react quickly to trends and work within budgets and deadlines. Floral Designers are employed by retail florists, interior landscape firms, garden centers and greenhouses.
