Curriculum Code: 0119 (Effective Fall 2009 – Summer 2014)

This degree is designed for students who intend to transfer to a four-year college or university to pursue a baccalaureate degree in the humanities, interdisciplinary studies, cultural studies or related subject areas. Students completing this curriculum will also satisfy the MACRAO Transfer Agreement between two-year and four-year institutions in Michigan. General education and subject area requirements vary from one college or university to another.
