Curriculum Code: 1017 (Effective Fall 2011 – Summer 2013)

This certificate curriculum prepares individuals to function competently in the central service department of a healthcare facility. Duties include, but are not limited to, processing of patient care equipment, supplies, and instruments for use in all departments. Includes principles and practices of decontamination, cleaning, disinfection, sterilization, and distribution of medical/surgical supplies. The curriculum provides externship experience and prepares the successful completer for the National Certification Exam for Sterile Processing and Distribution.
