NOTES:

1. Students should meet with a Human Services Program advisor prior to or during their first semester to complete an educational plan, to discuss further education, and obtain course offering information.
2. GERO, HUSE, and SOWK courses must be completed with a minimum 2.5 grade or higher to be counted toward the certificate of completion.
3. A maximum of 3 credits of GERO seminars may be used to satisfy CHOICE 1 requirements.
4. Students may also choose up to 3 credits of Human Services Program electives upon approval from the Human Services Program administrator.
5. Students may choose a maximum of 2 credits from different topics of special interest.
6. Students pursuing an education in addictions must choose HUSE 112 and HUSE 242 from the "LIMITED CHOICE REQUIREMENTS".
