Curriculum Code: 1358 (Effective Fall 2011 – Summer 2016)

The Music Technology Certificate of Completion combines practical and applied coursework in audio production, recording, MIDI composition, music fundamentals, and keyboard skills. Students develop technical and creative skills in the field of music and sound through access to state of the art sound recording and electronic music studios. Diverse opportunities exist to develop performance skills. Most of the courses in this certificate fulfill degree requirements for the AAA degrees in Music: Commercial (0274) and Music Management (0861).
