

# **THE AMY D. HAYES MEMORIAL POETRY AWARD**

This award will be given annually to a Lansing Community College student who submits a selection of poetry found to be worthy of artistic merit by a review panel composed of faculty members of the LCC English Program. The winner will receive an award of \$250. Students who have declared Literature/English as a major area of study are eligible to compete.

*Amy D. Hayes* was a student at Lansing Community College and winner of the Peter Edmunds Poetry Competition before transferring to the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor. A graduate of U of M, Ms. Hayes was twice the recipient of the Hopgood Award. She was also named a 2001 Cranbrook Award winner posthumously.

Those students wishing to apply for this award are asked to submit a small portfolio of their poetry. Three to five poems may be submitted. Each poem should be presented in typed manuscript form (one poem to a page, in a 12-point font). Pages should have headers with the student's name and student number. Sheets of poetry should be attached with a paper clip. The package of cover page and poems should be submitted in a large envelope, so that the pages are not folded.
