

## Tips for scheduling LCC portion of CMU Lansing Program – 2008-09

Begin with:

- Mathematics. MATH 112 requires a placement level of 5, ISCI 121 requires a math level of 4.
- WRIT 121\*
- EDUC 220 \*                      \* = must be completed with a 3.0 or better before admission
- EDUC 201 \*                      to CMU College of Education.

EDUC 220 and EDUC 201 must be taken before you take ARTS 240 or ARTS will not transfer.

ISCI 121 is offered Fall or Spring, but ISCI 122 is not guaranteed to be offered except in Spring semester. These two courses should be your first science classes.

BIOL 229 is generally offered only in the Fall. It is recommended that you take it after you have completed ISCI 121/122

GEOG 121 will be offered Fall and Spring. The other weather option, GEOG 220 will be offered only in the Fall.

Students who completed the MUSC 200 before the end of Spring 2007 semester have satisfied the music requirement and do not have to take MUS 330 as a CMU course.

GEOL 221 and 222 do not have to be taken in sequence. GEOL 221 offered only in the Fall, GEOL 222 is offered only in Spring.

Other courses that are generally NOT available in the summer are:

Foreign Language (Except Spanish)  
EDUC 201

ISCI 121 or 122  
MATH 201/202

Online sections are offered for ASTR 201, BIOL 145, HIST 211 or 212, EDUC 220, EDUC 204, ENGL 208, GEOG 200, PSYC 200, SPCH 120, SOCL 120, WRIT 121, WRIT 122. Seats are limited, so register early.

### Suggested Schedule

The following is a suggested schedule of LCC courses & the current plan for CMU courses. (Does not include MUS 330). LCC students will only be able to begin the CMU sequence in a Spring semester. (Application deadline in Spring of previous year.) Note that the underlined courses must be completed before applying to the CMU Education program. Once you begin CMU classes you must take all CMU courses available when they are offered.
