LANSING COMMUNITY COLLEGE ANNOUNCES NEW CLASS REGISTRATION SCHEDULE

LANSING, MICH. (June 12, 2008) – Lansing Community College has announced a new class registration schedule that allows students with more credits to register prior to individuals with fewer or no credits.

Students will be able to register for classes based on the following chart.

Students with:	Registration begins on:
90 credits or more	June 25, 2008 at midnight
60 credits or more	June 25, 2008 at noon
30 credits or more	June 26, 2008 at midnight
12 credits or more	June 26, 2008 at noon
All remaining students	June 27, 2008 at midnight

In previous years, registration was open to all students at the same time regardless of credits earned.

“Similar schedules are used at universities and colleges across the country,” said INSERT NAME, INSERT TITLE. “By staggering the times that students can register, we give students who are nearing graduation a better chance at getting into classes that they need to earn their degrees while also reducing the load on our computer systems.”
