LCC Attempts to Break the Guinness Book of World Records *Proceeds to Benefit LCC Student Scholarships and Gateway/Crossroads Community Services*

LANSING – All are invited to come and witness Chef Nick (William Nicklosovich) of the LCC Culinary Arts program in an attempt to break the Guinness Book of World Records at making the world's largest slab of chocolate and chocolate **mint** fudge. The current record is 5050 pounds. On Monday, June 29, Chef Nick and several volunteers intend to break that record by making 6,000 pounds of fudge at Lansing Community College's West Campus located at 5708 Cornerstone Drive Lansing, Michigan 48917.

The public may view and buy the fudge beginning at 11:00 am. At 3:00 pm Lansing Mayor Virg Bernero and LCC President Brent Knight and other special guests will be present during a ceremony. Other special guests include Rocket Ismail of the Dallas Cowboys, Bobby Jon Drinkard of CBS television show Survivor, Byron Williams of the New York Giants and many others. The mint being used was donated by Peppermint Jim of St. Johns, MI.

Fudge sales are going on now at <http://www.lcc.edu/foundation/>. The cost is \$10.00 per pound. Proceeds from these sales go to scholarships at Lansing Community College and to Gateway/Crossroads community Services for homeless teenagers.
