Traffic Alert for 1st Day of LCC's Summer Semester

LANSING – North Grand Avenue will be closed for 12 hours Saturday when more than 10,000 people are expected to gather to sample the food and enjoy Lansing's riverfront during the 16th Annual Lansing Board of Water & Light Chili Cook-off.

The City of Lansing will shut down Grand Avenue to traffic from 11:30 a.m. until 11:30 p.m. from Shiawassee Street to Saginaw Street to accommodate the popular event.

Access to LCC's Gannon Parking Ramp will be available by taking Saginaw Street and turning right (south) onto Grand Avenue (Grand is a one-way going north, but the city has made special arrangements.) On June 4, parking is free of charge in the Gannon ramp.
