- ① A 2.0 minimum or Passing (P) grade is required in this course. The credits and grade will not be used in calculating GPA and credits for admission.
- ② If not taken at LCC, **must** cover BCLS for adults, children, and infants (i.e., American Heart Assoc/Health Care Provider or American Red Cross/Professional Rescuer). A **current** card must be submitted for the program application deadline.
- ③ **If this course was taken more than 8 years prior to being admitted into the Nursing Program it must be repeated. Exceptions may be granted by the Nursing Program Director after evaluation, if applicable. A comprehensive exam or course final will be accepted in lieu of a course repeat, if available.**
- ④ Although not required for graduation, BIOL 204 is required to transfer to a 4-year college/university and the credit and grade will be used in calculating GPA and credits for admission.
- ⑤ **NURS 200 may be taken no earlier than two years prior to application to the program. If taken more than two years prior to application, or a grade of less than 2.5 was earned, the course must be retaken.**
- ⑥ This **CORE** requirement can be satisfied with a 2.0 GPA or greater, or can be waived if student has an Associate's, Bachelor's, or higher degree.
- ⑦ Requirements met with proof of Bachelor's Degree.

* Although the college requirement for these courses is 2.0 GPA, the program requires a 2.5.
