SELECTION PROCESS**

I - Admission Requirements

1. Student picks up an application packet at the Fire Academy Office, West Campus Room M127, or at the LCC Fire Academy Web page located at www.lcc.edu.
2. Applications are completed and returned to the Fire Academy Office.
3. The Fire Academy staff will schedule applicants for an oral board interview.
4. At the interview, the following documents will be required:
 - a. A valid drivers license
 - b. A copy of the student's driving record

II - Admission Ranking

Within Michigan, but not within the LCC resident district	05 pts.

2. **GRADE POINT AVERAGE**

3.6 - 4.0	20 pts.
3.0 - 3.5	15 pts.
2.0 - 2.9	10 pts.

3. **EDUCATIONAL LEVEL**

Masters Degree or higher	20 pts
Bachelors	15 pts.
Associate Degree	10 pts.
High School Diploma	05 pts.

4. **INTERVIEW** 50 pts.

5. **FIRE DEPARTMENT MEMBERSHIP OR FIRE SERVICE INVOLVEMENT**

Full Time	20 pts.
Part Time Paid	15 pts.
On Call Paid	10 pts.
Completed a high school fire science curriculum or	05 pts.
Currently enrolled in a Fire Science/EMT/Paramedic program at LCC	

Admissions will tally all scores and rank order of applicants.

Letters of Admission will be sent to accepted applicants with additional instructions.

Students not accepted will need to reapply for a future academy.
