- January 15: End 100% refund tuition and fees (full semester only)
- January 18: Martin Luther King Holiday: College closed
- January 22: End 50% refund tuition and facility fee only (full semester only)
- February 5: Last day to change residency
- March 6–12: Spring Break (no classes)
- May 7: Last day of spring semester
- May 7: Deadline to submit associate degree/certificate application for Spring Semester 2010
- May 14: Commencement (Jack Breslin Student Events Center, 7 p.m.)

Your LCC Student E-mail Account is your one-stop source for all LCC news, updates and student account information. Check it regularly to receive alerts such as:

- **Information on Campus/Community Events**

FACTS Tuition and Fee Payment Plan

Effective July 1, 2009 all students are required to either:

- **Pay tuition and fees in full**
- **Sign up for the FACTS Installment Payment Plan**
- **Sign up for the FACTS Pending Aid Payment Plan (available to financial aid recipients)**
- **Submit Third Party Authorization (if an employer, high school or agency is sponsoring a student's education). This does not include financial aid**

Students who do not complete one of the above options by their payment due date will be dropped from **all** of their classes. Payment due dates are based upon the day a student registers. Payments are due by the due date listed on the student bill. Student bills will be available to view in Banner Student Self Service. Each time a new bill is generated, students will be notified through their LCC Student E-mail account.

About the FACTS Payment Plan

The FACTS monthly payment plan helps students manage their educational expenses. This is not a loan program. Students have no accumulated debt, no interest or finance charges are assessed, and no credit check is required. The cost to participate in the payment plan is \$25 per semester. Students choosing to participate in the plan pay for tuition and fees by authorizing either a monthly automatic bank deduction or monthly credit/debit card payment (MasterCard, Discover, or American Express). Once the plan is activated, FACTS will automatically withdraw a payment on the fifth of each month from the designated account or credit card.

The Lansing CC Debit Card: A new way to receive refunds from LCC

The new Lansing CC Debit Card offers students a faster way to receive financial aid and other LCC refunds.

The debit card is being provided automatically to most LCC students in partnership with Higher One, a financial services company, focused solely on bringing college students a new method for receiving funds. The Lansing CC Debit Card comes with the opportunity to open the OneAccount, a free debit checking account provided to students through Higher One.

After receiving the debit card by mail, students must activate their refund preference. (Do not throw away this important card. Activate it as soon as it is received.) During the refund activation process, students will choose one of the following options for receiving their refund money at www.LansingCCDebitCard.com.

1. Direct deposit to a Higher One checking account. Choosing Easy Refund into the OneAccount is the fastest refund option (one business day).

2. Deposit to another bank of the student's choice (three to five business days).

The new Lansing CC Debit Card will be mailed to the current address on file for the student. It is critical that students make sure LCC has a current mailing address in the Banner Student System. Take a moment today to verify it. Go to www.lcc.edu, click **Star Port**, then **Banner** followed by **Personal Information**.
