General Education: Transfer students may fulfill the general education requirement with courses from previously attended colleges and universities. Students at Oakland University must satisfy 8 areas: Arts; Literature; Language; Western Civilization; International Studies; Social Science; Mathematics; Logic and Computer Science; and Natural Science and Technology. NOTE: A three-semester hour transfer course may serve as the required course in a particular field category, but students must still present a total of 32 credits and all eight categories must be represented.
