

# ASSESSMENT OF STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES

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## **I. Purpose**

## **III. General**

The College will implement assessment of student learning outcomes in all curricula, courses, and educational activities. Assessment of student learning outcomes will be on-going, guide all curricular activities, and be used to improve the teaching and learning process.

## **IV. Responsibility**

The responsibility for the interpretation and administration of this policy is delegated to the Provost/Senior Vice President of Academic Affairs or his/her designee.
