Confirm with an Academic Advisor at your college if the class you want to take transfers back to your college and fits in your program. 	<p>To Learn More</p> <p>transfer.msu.edu</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p style="text-align: center;">Complete an Application</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Go to www.lcc.edu and click “APPLY” to apply for admissions online. Domestic students attending another college wanting to transfer credits back to their college choose Guest-Attending Other College. After submitting your application, you may receive your student number (X00-----). Write down this important number. <input type="checkbox"/>	<p style="text-align: center;">Activate Your Account</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Go to www.lcc.edu and click on myLCC. Click on Activate My Account. Enter your LCC student number and birthdate. Agree to the Acceptable Use Policy. Set your password and recovery info. Click Submit and your username will display. <input type="checkbox"/>	<p style="text-align: center;">Waive Prerequisites or Take Placement Tests</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you have passed a college level writing, math, or liberal arts class at your college, you may be eligible to waive your Reading, Writing, and Math prerequisites. You also may be able to waive prerequisites with certain ACT or SAT scores or an Associates or higher degree. Complete a Waiver form. The requirements to waive prerequisites are listed on the back of the form. Submit an unofficial transcript or ACT/SAT score report with the Waiver form. <input type="checkbox"/>	<p style="text-align: center;">Pay Your Bill</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sign up for a payment plan or pay online through Banner. You can also pay by cash at the Main Campus, Student Finance Office. Check for payment deadlines so you will not be dropped from your classes for nonpayment. If you select a payment plan you will need to indicate where a potential refund will go.
