

Phase I

Prior to beginning the application process, all non-MRIT courses must be completed with a passing grade of 2.5 or better.

1. Complete all LCC requirements for general admission to the college lcc.edu/apply.
2. All transcripts from other colleges and universities must be received by LCC's Enrollment Services by January 1, 2019 in order to be considered for 2019 admission.

Phase II

Admission to the MRI program through Lansing Community College is based on points. Points are awarded based on academic achievement and total GPA from all institutions attended. Applicants are then ranked accordingly. Documentation of grades in required courses must be provided via student transcript.

1. Calculated GPA in required courses. See attached Magnetic Resonance Imaging Technology AAS Pathway for details.
 - 3.60-4.00—20 points
 - 3.10- 3.59—15 points
 - 2.50-3.00—5 points
2. The following courses earn additional points:
 - Grades of 4.0 or 3.5 earn 8 points for first attempt, 6 points for second attempt
 - Grade of 3.0 earns 5 points for first attempt, 3 point for second attempt
 - BIOL 201
 - BIOL 202
 - ENGL 121 or 122 or ENGL 131 or 132
 - COMM 110 or 120
3. The following courses earn additional points:
 - Grades of 4.0 or 3.5 earn 4 points for first attempt, 3 points for second attempt
 - Grade of 3.0 earns 2 points for first attempt, 1 point for second attempt.
 - PHYS 120 or 200
 - MATH 121 or STAT 170 or 215
 - SOCL 120

Please attach the following documents to this application. Additional points are available for these documents. If the following documentation is not received before the deadline, your application will not be eligible for consideration.

1. Letter of Intent (5 points)
Please submit a 250-300 word letter indicating why you are interested in pursuing a career in magnetic resonance imaging and why you feel you would be a successful student in this online/hybrid program.
2. Letters of Recommendation (4 points)
Please submit two (2) letters of recommendation.
 - One letter of recommendation must be from a supervisor who has worked with you within the past three (3) years. Letters of recommendation from supervisors must be on company letterhead, signed, and mailed directly to the MRI campus program coordinator.
 - The second letter of recommendation must be from a co-worker who has worked with you within the past three (3) years. This can be attached to your application.
