Thank you for your interest in LCC's 2022/23 online EMS Instructor/Coordinator course. Here are the course details:

Course dates:	August 18 - December 12, 2022 didactic course content January 9 - March 13, 2023 student teaching (32 hours required)
Format:	Online lecture and assignments to be completed weekly throughout semester at times of the student's choosing. No face-to-face class sessions. There will, however, be three required virtual class sessions at which attendance is required: December 7, 8, 9, 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. each day.
Student teaching:	May be completed either at the student's local EMS agency or within their local community under the supervision of a licensed Michigan I/C, or within EMS courses at LCC.
I/C licensure:	Upon successful course completion, student is qualified to take the Michigan Instructor/Coordinator licensure exam. <b>NOTE: In order to qualify for licensure, the State of Michigan requires three years of service as a licensed EMS provider at any level (MFR, EMT, EMT-S, EMT-P) with a life support agency or combination of life support agencies.</b>
Course cost:	within LCC district: \$1,648.00* outside of LCC district: \$2,902.00* *includes all tuition and fees; subject to slight increase as determined by action of the LCC Board of Trustees
