Curriculum Code: 0709 (Effective Fall 2015 – Summer 2016)

The Regional Fire Training Center provides the Fire Academy Certificate Program to prepare individuals in basic fire training and fitness. Successful completion leads to certification by the Michigan Fire Fighter Training Council for Fire Fighter I and II, Hazardous Materials Awareness, Hazardous Materials Operations, Auto Extrication, Advanced Stabilization, NIMS 100 and 200, and Wildland Fire Fighter II through the National Wildfire Coordinating Group.

The Fire Science Academy requires department approval. In order to be considered as a candidate for this program, students must meet basic admission requirements beyond those required for admission to the college.
