Certificate of Completion

Curriculum Code: 1352 (Effective Fall 2015 – Summer 2020)

The Certificate of Completion in Musicianship Studies provides basic training in music theory, aural skills, keyboard harmony, solo and ensemble performance for: a) students preparing to transfer to college or university Music programs; b) qualifying dual-enrolled high school or home school students; or c) those seeking to reinforce their own professional musical competencies. The focus is on skills acquisition most necessary for successfully meeting audition and music placement requirements. Students may also apply all courses in this curriculum toward AAA degrees in Music, Music: Commercial, and Music Management. **Not all courses in this program transfer to all colleges.**

#### PREREQUISITES

In order to meet the prerequisites for some Music major courses, students must complete the following requirements:

- a. Interview with a Performing Arts advisor to discuss curriculum requirements, musical repertoires and audition procedures.
- b. Perform an audition on an instrument or voice to be adjudicated by LCC Music faculty.
- c. Take a Music Theory Placement Test covering music reading skills and basic harmony.
