This certificate is designed to prepare a person to safely and skillfully work as an EKG technician, also known as a cardiology technician at certain facilities. An EKG technician works primarily in a hospital but could also work in an outpatient clinic or cardiology practice. This position is occasionally combined with respiratory therapy. Completers of this curriculum meet the requirements for EKG technician certification.
