Certificate of Achievement

Curriculum Code: 1482 (Effective Fall 2015 – Summer 2020)

This certificate is designed to provide learning experiences in several academic disciplines for students who intend to transfer to a four-year college or university to pursue a baccalaureate degree. Students who complete this certificate will satisfy the General Education requirements of all LCC Associate in Arts and Associate in Science degrees. Please note that some degrees require students to take specific General Education course in some areas. This curriculum also satisfies the [Michigan Transfer Agreement \(MTA\)](#), which is designed to facilitate transfer from one institution to another. The thirty credit hours of lower-level general education from the sending institution will be accepted as a block of 30 credit hours by the receiving institution. Students may complete the Michigan Transfer Agreement as part of an associate degree or as a stand-alone package. Transfer students and Associate in Arts and Associate in Science degree seekers are **strongly** encouraged to apply for this certificate, as it clearly announces to four-year colleges and university that the student has successfully completed the MTA.

While many Michigan colleges and universities honor the Michigan Transfer Agreement, some may have further or more specific requirements. Students should check with the receiving institution regarding its transfer policies. **At least one credit-bearing course must be earned in attendance at Lansing Community College.**

Prior to beginning this curriculum, students should contact the Academic Advising Department, Gannon Building – StarZone, telephone number (517) 483-1904, to consult with an academic advisor. Students should also contact the school to which they will transfer for specific transfer institution requirements.

Complete the indicated number of courses from the approved list of LCC courses that satisfy the [Michigan Transfer Agreement \(MTA\)](#) for each category below. (See Note 1).

A: English Composition: One course

B: English Composition (second course) **or Communication:** One course

C: Humanities and Fine Arts: A total of 2 courses, each from a different discipline

D: Mathematics: One course from Quantitative Reasoning, College Algebra, or Statistics

E: Natural Sciences: A total of 2 courses, each from a different discipline; one must be a lab course

F: Social Science: A total of 2 courses, each from a different discipline

NOTE:

1. To receive this certificate of achievement, students must complete all required courses with a minimum grade of 2.0.
