NOTES:

1. Students who anticipate continuing their education into the Human Services Certificate of Achievement and applying for practicum placement must meet with the Human Services Program Director prior to or during their first semester to complete an educational plan, and obtain course and practicum information.
2. GERO, HUSE, and SOWK courses must be completed with a minimum 2.5 grade or higher to be counted toward this Certificate of Completion as well as for practicum placement.
3. For a practicum placement in Aging/Older Adults, students must select 3 credits from GERO 164-191 plus 3-4 credits of any other course(s) listed in CHOICE 1. For a practicum placement in Children and Families, students must select HUSE 110 plus 3-4 credits of any other course(s) listed in CHOICE 1. For a practicum placement in Addictions, students must select HUSE 112 plus 3 credits of any other course(s) listed in CHOICE 1. Students may also seek Human Services Program Director approval for other courses that may fulfill other types of practicum placements in Human Services.

Students should see course descriptions to find out when departments plan to offer courses. Students who for any reason are unable to follow the course sequence suggested below (for example, those who are part-time, have transferred in courses from another school, or have prerequisites to fulfill) should contact an academic advisor for help with adjustments.
