The Therapeutic Massage Program prepares an individual in the field of therapeutic massage and bodywork. Massage therapists may be employed in private practice or in a variety of health care settings, spas, and exercise facilities. The Program is approved through the National Certification Board for Therapeutic Massage and Bodywork (NCBTMB) and is accredited by the Commission on Massage Therapy Accreditation (COMTA), 5335 Wisconsin Avenue NW, Suite 440, Washington, DC 20015. Successful completion of the program prepares an individual for testing through MBLEx (Massage and Bodywork Licensing Exam.)
