**Admission Requirements**

*This is a selective admission program. Students will be admitted through the process using Nursing-RN Option (please see curriculum code 0222). In order to be considered as a candidate for this program, students must meet basic admission requirements beyond those required for admission to the college. Many of the courses for this program are open only to students officially admitted to the Nursing Program. This curriculum is Level I and Level II of the Registered Nurse Program.*

**Note:** All NURS courses in this curriculum must be completed with a minimum grade of 3.0 and all other courses must be completed with a minimum grade of 2.5 or to earn the Certificate of Achievement.
