Phlebotomy Technician C.C. Pathway

This certificate curriculum is designed to prepare a person to function as a phlebotomy technician. It will provide the knowledge, skills, and externship experience that is necessary to safely and skillfully obtain a blood specimen from a patient. A phlebotomist may work in a variety of settings such as hospitals, outpatient labs, physicians' offices, or clinics.

Note:

Students must enroll in CHSE 144 within one year of completing CHSE 143 with a minimum grade of 2.5. CHSE 144 must also be completed with a minimum grade of 2.5 to receive this certificate.
