**Teacher Paraprofessional A.A.S. Pathway**

Teacher Paraprofessionals (parapros) work under the direction of a classroom teacher in settings ranging from early childhood through elementary, middle school and high school. This curriculum meets federal requirements for teacher parapros. Some of the duties of the teacher parapros include working with small groups of children on their reading, math, and writing development; collecting and recording data on student performance; using technology for instructional purposes; and carrying out the instructional objectives of the classroom teacher. In addition, the teacher parapros must be able to communicate effectively with parents, students, and teachers; implement behavior management techniques; and recognize a range of special needs.

**Additional Information**

Students in this program choose one subspecialty pathway: 1) Early Childhood, 2) Elementary Education, or 3) Special Education, to determine the courses to take each semester. The Early Childhood specialty focuses on children 0-5 years while the Elementary specialty focuses on ages 6-12 years, and the Special Education specialty includes working with those with disabilities 3 years through young adult. This program can also be a first step toward teacher certification. Not all courses in this program transfer to all colleges. Students planning to transfer should see an academic advisor before enrolling in any course.

Upon completion of a subspecialty, any additional subspecialty courses will not count toward the student's enrollment level for determining financial aid eligibility.

Students completing subspecialty requirements for Early Childhood will fulfill the requirements for the Science Core area.

Some transfer universities require a 3.0 or higher in EDUC courses.

CHDV courses require a 2.5 exit grade.
