EMS Instructor-Coordinator C.C. Pathway

The EMS Instructor-Coordinator course is intended for licensed EMS practitioners who have interest in teaching initial EMS education courses and/or conducting EMS continuing education sessions. The LCC IC course meets all State of Michigan curriculum and content requirements. The curriculum provides the opportunity for building and developing teaching skills that will lead to instructional and administrative expertise in accordance with applicable state requirements for EMS educators. Students who successfully complete this course are eligible to sit for the State of Michigan EMS Instructor-Coordinator licensure exam. Additionally, the State of Michigan also requires that EMS Instructor-Coordinator licensure candidates provide proof of a minimum of three years of service with a life support agency prior to sitting for the exam.

Note:

Students must complete all courses with a minimum grade of 3.0 to receive this certificate.
