AIS Heavy Equipment Repair Training Institute - Associated Equipment Distributors (AED) National Certification (Earned after Award of AIS Certificate of Completion)

The Certificate of Completion to AAS Degree Initiative provides a path to completion of an Associate's of Applied Science degree for students who have completed the AIS Heavy Equipment Repair Training Program, received the AIS Certificate of Completion, and been awarded the Associated Equipment Distributors (AED) National Certification. Qualified AIS students will use the Lansing Community College Credit for Licensure/Certification process to apply their AED National Certification to the LCC classes identified in this guide.

Advising Notes:

1. AIS Certificate of Completion awardees who have earned the Associated Equipment Distributors (AED) National Certification will receive 41 credits toward the Heavy Equipment Repair Technician – AAS Degree, awarded through Lansing Community College’s Credit through Licensure/Certification process.
2. Remaining credits to completion of the AAS degree include one course from the Limited Choice group (3-4 credits) and one course from each General Education category: Composition, 2nd Composition or Communication, Mathematics or Applied Mathematics, Science or Applied Science, Social Science or Applied Social Science or Humanities or Applied Social Science.
3. General Education requirements represent a total of 17 – 21 credits (choosing General Education courses other than those recommended by the Program, while fulfilling General Education requirements, may require credits beyond the 17 listed in this guide.
4. Total credits required to complete the AAS degree range from 20 to 25, for a total of 61 to 66 total degree credits.
5. Additional coursework to meet prerequisite or placement-level requirements for Limited Choice and General Education courses may be required.
6. Students who have not earned the Associated Equipment Distributors (AED) National Certification may apply to receive credit for various courses through LCC’s Credit by Examination process. These students should meet with the designated Department representative in order to identify appropriate courses and examinations prior to applying for Credit by Examination.
