

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN LANSING COMMUNITY COLLEGE
AND CENTRAL MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY
REGARDING THE COLLEGE OF BUSINESS**

STATEMENT OF COOPERATION

Lansing Community College (LCC) and Central Michigan University (CMU) wish to facilitate the transfer of students who complete an associate's degree at Lansing Community College to a bachelor's degree program at CMU. This Agreement is intended to clarify the terms and conditions of transfers for students.

AGREEMENT

Lansing Community College and Central Michigan University hereby agree as follows:

1. A person who has earned an associates degree from Lansing Community College, with a concentration in Business Administration, and achieved the minimum grade requirements specified by CMU may transfer all credits earned at Lansing Community College to CMU.

2. A person who has earned an associates degree from Lansing Community College, with a concentration in Business Administration, and has followed the attached Articulation Guide, may transfer all credits specified on the Articulation Guide towards the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration degree at CMU. A person who has the required associates degree and a 2.50 or higher GPA will be admitted to CMU at the Junior class level and considered as having fulfilled the MACRAO agreement for CMU's University Program. Total maximum credits for graduation will vary based on major selection. To complete requirements for graduation from CMU, students who follow the attached Articulation Guide must also:

a) Complete a minimum of 33 hours scheduled through the College of Business Administration at CMU and must include MGT 495. CMU requires a minimum of 60 academic hours from a four-year institution.

b) Complete the remaining program requirements, distribution requirements and other College of Business Administration requirements listed in the CMU Bulletin and any other graduation requirements that are lacking.

c) Apply and be admitted to the College of Business Administration program at CMU. By completing this attached articulation guide, a student will be granted admissions to Professional Business Studies as soon as he/she begins their academic coursework at CMU, however, continued admission requires that he/she must earn a 2.50 GPA or higher during his/her first semester and complete any additional courses required for admissions. Graduates of Lansing Community College will receive equal consideration with other students seeking admission.


3. Lansing Community College and CMU agree to cooperate by communicating with each other and with their common and respective publics concerning this established relationship.


4. Lansing Community College and CMU agree to review this articulation guide annually to assure that it continues to be accurate and that it reflects curriculum changes which affect its terms. Either institution may decide to terminate the agreement concerning this academic program with written notice of 180 days in advance of the termination date. In the event of termination, both parties agree to work together to assist students all ready enrolled with completion of this program.

5. Lansing Community College and CMU further agree to communicate concerning the development of plans which might lead to future opportunities for cooperation between the two institutions. Responsibility for communications related to the agreement will be given at CMU to the Dean of the College of Business Administration and/or his/her designee, Director of Student Services and at Lansing Community College to the Dean of the Careers Division and/or his/her designee.



Students are required to complete a minimum of 60 credit hours at an accredited 4-year degree-granting institution in order to graduate. **ADDENDUM
TO

**CENTRAL MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY
MT. PLEASANT, MICHIGAN**


1. It is mutually understood that the following paragraph #10 shall be added to the Articulation Agreement to transfer prescribed coursework as outlined in Appendix (A) from Lansing Community College (LCC) towards completion of a Bachelor of Science in Education Degree from Central Michigan University (CMU). The addendum shall become effective upon execution by both parties and shall continue in effect for the duration of the Articulation Agreement originally executed May 10th, 2006:


That CMU agrees that in the event the agreement is not renewed, CMU guarantees that all required courses shall be available within a three year period from the admission date or until students who have been admitted into the final cohort have completed all requirements. Students, who are unable to complete required courses when offered in Lansing, may apply to the CMU main campus for completion of the program.


2. That all remaining provisions contained within the currently existing memorandum of agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
