


**AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE HONORS PROGRAM OF
LANSING COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND THE LEE HONORS COLLEGE OF
WESTERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY**

The Honors Program of Lansing Community College (LCC) and the Lee Honors College of Western Michigan University (WMU) hereby enter into the following agreement concerning Honors students at Lansing Community College who wish to continue to work at Western Michigan University. (This agreement will continue for five years and will then be reviewed and, if necessary, renegotiated.)


1. All LCC Honors students wishing to continue their Honors work at WMU must first be admitted to the University.
2. Students who have participated in the Honors Program at LCC will be automatically admitted to the Honors College of WMU. A letter from the Honors Program coordinator will confirm the student's participation in the LCC Honors Program. Upon admission, the student will consult with the dean, the associate dean, or the academic advisor of the Honors College of WMU to establish an appropriate course of study in the Honors College. Graduation from the Honors College of WMU will occur when this course of study is completed.

The Lansing Community College Honors Program and the Western Michigan University Lee Honors College will work cooperatively to make candid assessments of the students and the level of work required in both programs. Both programs will notify each other concerning contemplated curricular changes that would affect this agreement.




