Mason Promise Scholarship

Mason Promise Scholarship Program	
WHAT	The Mason Promise Scholarship Program offers Mason Public School youth an opportunity for a college education & a brighter future. Students were initiated into the program as sixth graders & promised to finish high school within Mason Public Schools; in exchange students, receive two years of free tuition and fees at Lansing Community College
ATTEND & GRADUATE	The student must be enrolled in Mason Public Schools or an affiliated MPS program at least 75% of their 6th through 12th grade years, and must be enrolled their entire final year
APPLY to COLLEGE	Students must apply and be accepted to Lansing Community College
FAFSA	All Mason Promise students must apply online at www.fafsa.ed.gov for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by March 1st and complete verification by July 1st prior to the fall semester each year.
WHEN	Student must begin classes at Lansing Community College within two (2) years of high school graduation from Mason High School and before reaching age 21.
GPA	Students are expected to stay in good academic standing while in college to maintain their scholarship. Good academic standing at LCC is outlined in the Satisfactory Academic Progress Policies .

Lansing Community College's 2019-2020 Mason Promise Scholarships FAQs

Question	Answer
Is there a minimum amount of credits I need to enroll in to receive my scholarship?	Yes, Mason Promise Scholars must be enrolled full-time; a minimum of 12 credits during fall and spring semesters and 6 credits during summer semester.
Will I lose my scholarship if I do not start at Lansing Community College (LCC) the fall after I graduated from High School?	No, Mason Promise Scholars have two years from high school graduation to enroll at LCC to receive their scholarship, or before turning 21 years of age.
Will I still receive my scholarship if I earned LCC college credit while still in high school?	Yes.
I had problems completing the Free Application For Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and I missed the July 1 st deadline, will I still receive my scholarship?	Please contact LCC's K-12 <i>Scholarship Coordinator</i> (contact info below), as these are reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
Will I still receive my scholarship if my FAFSA is "rejected"?	Please contact LCC's K-12 <i>Scholarship Coordinator</i> , as these are reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
Will I lose my scholarship if I fail or withdraw from a class?	All scholarship students are required to meet with their <i>Academic Success Coach</i> to create their academic success plan. Please contact LCC's K-12 <i>Scholarship Coordinator</i> , as these are reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
Will I lose my scholarship if I fall into Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) Suspension?	All scholarship students are required to meet with their <i>Academic Success Coach</i> to maintain their scholarship. Please contact LCC's K-12 <i>Scholarship Coordinator</i> , as these are reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
Will I lose my scholarship if I take a semester off?	No, Mason Promise Scholars do not have a consecutive term requirement.
May I use my scholarship for summer classes?	Scholars may enroll in any summer term only after their first full fall and/or spring semester in college of receiving their award as it adheres to the scholarship terms.
