Job placement rates for 2020-2021 Graduates:

88% of all career-related (occupational) graduates reported being employed on the Graduate Follow-Up surveys (133/152)

- **84%** of associate degree career-related (occupational) graduates reported being employed (62/74)
- **91%** of certificate career-related (occupational) graduates reported being employed (71/78)

How job placement rates are calculated:

Select graduates of career-related (occupational) degrees and certificates who answered the employment status question on the Graduate Follow-Up Survey

Number of graduates who reported being employed / (Total number of graduates responding to employment status question – Number of graduates who reported they were not employed but they were not looking for employment) = Job Placement Rate
