Job placement rates for 2021-2022 Graduates:

89% of all career-related (occupational) graduates reported being employed on the Graduate Follow-Up surveys (137/154)

- **92%** of associate degree career-related (occupational) graduates reported being employed (79/86)
- **85%** of certificate career-related (occupational) graduates reported being employed (58/68)

How job placement rates are calculated:

Select graduates of career-related (occupational) degrees and certificates who answered the employment status question on the Graduate Follow-Up Survey

Number of graduates who reported being employed, military, or apprenticeship / (Total number of graduates responding to employment status question – Number of graduates who reported they were not employed but they were not looking for employment) = Job Placement Rate
