## Job placement rates for 2023-2024 Graduates:

**93%** of all career-related (occupational) graduates reported being employed on the Graduate Follow-Up surveys (79/85)

- **95%** of associate degree career-related (occupational) graduates reported being employed (40/42)
- **91%** of certificate career-related (occupational) graduates reported being employed (39/43)

## How job placement rates are calculated:

Select graduates of career-related (occupational) degrees and certificates who answered the employment status question on the Graduate Follow-Up Survey

Number of graduates who reported being employed, military, or apprenticeship / (Total number of graduates responding to employment status question – Number of graduates who reported they were not employed but they were not looking for employment) = Job Placement Rate

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
