FOUNDATION AWARDED OVER \$696,000 IN 2016 TO BENEFIT LCC AND LCC STUDENTS



The Lansing Community College Foundation awarded \$696,240 to Lansing Community College students and Lansing Community College during its fiscal year 2016. Of this amount, \$408,339 was awarded in student scholarships that assisted Mid-Michigan, out of state and international students. \$287,901 was awarded in grants to Lansing Community College to purchase instructional equipment and fund programs that benefited students, faculty, and staff.

Scholarship awarding for the 2016-2017 academic year is coming to a close. This year 920 scholarship applications were submitted through the online scholarship process which represents an increase of 46% applications since the online scholarship application was implemented. At this point, the Foundation has awarded over \$410,000 in scholarships to over 300 students. The Foundation will continue to award scholarships on a limited basis as funds become available.


