The below information was approved on 04/03/18 by the Curriculum Committee (CC) to be moved forward to the Academic Senate.

Revised Course Proposals:

MGMT 234 – Diversity in the Workplace

The Management & Leadership Program (Business, Communication and the Arts Department) stated that the proposed student learning outcome and evaluation changes to MGMT 234 serve to enhance students understanding of the dynamics of the diversity in the modern workplace by expanding their understanding of concepts such as inclusion and exclusion. In the revised course, students will continue to learn about minority groups and cultures. However, students will also explore oppression, inclusion, equity, inequity, etc., and what this looks like in the 21st century, global workplace. Additionally, students will analyze the relationship between diversity and inclusion and workplace management. The CC recommends the course revisions proposed for MGMT 234 (Diversity in the Workplace) move forward as a recommendation to the Academic Senate.
