### **New Course Proposals:**

#### **INSU 105 - Prin of Prop & Liability Ins**

The newly formed Insurance Program (Business, Communication, and the Arts) stated that this course is being created as part of the new Insurance Curriculum. Olivet, Ferris State University and Northwood, have all expressed an interest in developing an articulation agreement with LCC. The course outcomes for INSU 105 (Prin of Prop & Liability Ins) have come directly from the course outcomes for the same classes offered at these transfer institutions. Administration from Olivet, Ferris State University, and Northwood have been very supportive and encouraging - actually requesting that LCC develop an Insurance Program, as well as an articulation agreement or a 2+2 program.
