Sally decided that it should go to the Curriculum Committee for discussion. Here is the information we have on it: Program requesting a title change from Business Transfer Studies (BTS) to Interdisciplinary Business Studies, without a curriculum code change. Laurie forwarded the following from Jeremy Davis, Director, School of Business: "Interdisciplinary Studies is generic enough that it shouldn't make a difference to any of the old B&A (Business and Accounting) graduates and BTS students. The other rationale was that a student who has a BTS degree and doesn't transfer seems like they didn't achieve their goal or could be perceived as a failure for whatever reason.
