<b>Input and what issues have you seen that interfere with student success?</b>	10 minutes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Several members:</i> Food accessibility (whether by location or cost) remains an issue. Joann highlighted the bag lunches available for students at West Campus, which are a great resource, but only available until 5:00 PM due to logistical limitations.</li> <li>• <i>Ronda:</i> A dot survey will be used at the end of October to gather data on student interests and needs on a broad number of categories. These surveys will appear in every campus building. Results may be available by mid-November. It's hoped this may be a jumping off point for some larger conversations or initiatives.</li> <li>• <i>Joann:</i> We need to follow up on the ability for students to see the cost of textbooks before they register for classes (a topic discussed by the committee last year). Denise will reach out to Mary Ellen Laatsch for information.</li> </ul>
